
The sky is clear, the breeze is soft, and the sea is calm. Returning home along the path between the dunes and pine trees promises a haven of well-being.

The summer sun fills everything with a feeling of wonderful intensity.






I love the freshness of the plants in the garden, the morning walk at dawn, with the empty beach, the swim in the sea. Relaxing in the bathtub when I come back.

and closing your eyes.



The sand cluster, winding and warm.




The warmth of the brick walls, evoking the passing of time, and the objects invite us to disconnect.






The beach and its feelings of well-being. The dune and its sensuality. My favorite moment, the bath.





Oak wood brings harmony to the winding shape of Duna, evoking natural elements.







Comforting, relaxing and restorative, the bath is a unique moment for intimacy, in full communion with myself.






The effect of the sun and salt water on the skin is relaxing. Salt water is replaced by fresh water and bathing at home is a real pleasure.

Contact with natural materials, such as the cork of the step, provides the feeling of lightness and comfort.






Water as a purifying element and the bathtub as a space of beauty and well-being.

Feeling the calm of the dunes, winding and relaxing, with your eyes closed, in total mental and physical peace. Remembering the sound of the sea.






Blue.

Enjoy a unique moment with all five senses.






The bathroom conveys calm and peace through the flowing blue shapes and the connection with nature.

Peace and harmony.




Healing and stimulating space where the disconnection with the outside world immerses us in a state of utter calm.

emotions are let free.




A new world emerges around me

The candles scented with orange blossom.




The simplicity of the forms to complete the ritual of the senses.


The joy of flowers invades the rooms.





The beauty of nature takes us to lush gardens where one breathes freshness.






Going for an aimless

flowers, strolling unhurried.



illuminating everything.







Aroma.

Evoking the sunset with the setting sun, lying in the bathtub with the comfortable headrest, which hangs elegantly on the horizon of Duna.






More than objects.
